Research Support:

- MCATS supports research idea development, protocol design and ongoing research implementation.
- Through MCATS, University of Melbourne academics, including Honoraries, have access to grant development support. Ongoing MCATS collaboration is enabled through inclusion within grant budgets.
- MCATS also provides support for pilot project development, data analysis, systematic reviews and meta-analysis and grant re-submissions. Long or short-term support is available for your research group or department via co-contributions to an MCATS position.

Research training:

- Short courses include subjects such as Health Economics, Biostatistics, Grant writing & project development and information management (incl. REDCap).

We have helped numerous researchers enhance their research, and we look forward to helping you.

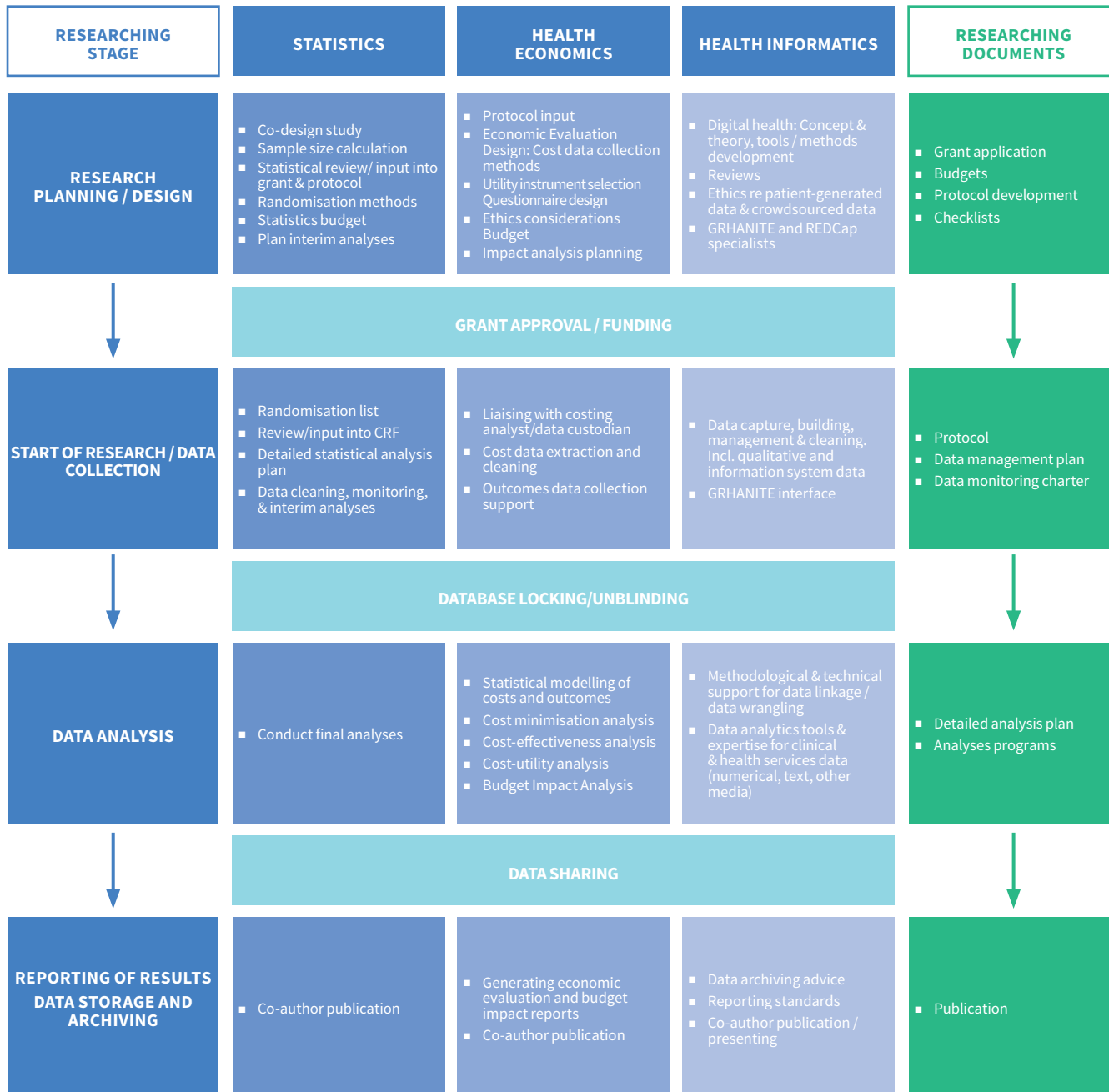
